



Pininfarina celebrates production of the 50,000th Mitsubishi Pajero Pinin

In November 2002 Pininfarina celebrates the 50,000th unit of the Mitsubishi Pajero Pinin to come off the production line at its Bairo plant.

The Mitsubishi Pajero Pinin is the result of a cooperation agreement between Mitsubishi and Pininfarina signed in Tokyo in January 1997 for engineering and production of this urban-style jeep aimed at the Sport Utility Vehicle market niche.

Marketing of the Pajero Pinin began back in autumn 1999 at the new Bairo plant with the 3-door version, later joined by the 5-door model in 2000. The current production range includes the 1.8 16V MPI and 2.0 16V GDI engine versions.
