

Operations at Bairo plant start again

June 29, 2007 - On Monday July 2 operations at Pininfarina plant of Bairo (Turin) will start again. Manufacturing activities had been stopped on June 15 following the violent tornado which struck the Canavese area.

The storm had seriously damaged both the structures (the wind blew the roof and the skylights off the building, lines were flooded, electrical equipment and electronic control systems were damaged) and many of the cars on the assembly lines and cars on stock.

The plant is operational again after just two weeks, in spite of the concerned Authorities expectations of a 4-6 week shutdown, thanks to the extraordinary work of a team specially established to face this emergency.
