

Primatist launches its G53' Pininfarina



It was presented as a preview during the recent Salone Nautico in Genoa and it will be exhibited at the Salon Nautico Internacional in Barcelona (8th – 16th November 2008): we are speaking about the **Primatist G53' Pininfarina**, the last model designed and produced by the cooperation between Primatist and Pininfarina. This boat, entirely produced by the new and ultra-modern shipyard in Arbatax, it is placed between the G70' Pininfarina – Primatist flagship – and the lucky G46' Pininfarina, and it reflects style and concept of these two models. Lines affinity, in fact, is evident at the first glance: electrohydraulic-lifted Aerotop which allows to enjoy the sea in all weather conditions, lateral lowered passageways that let passengers to easily reach the bow, kitchen placed in the external cockpit allowing to better exploit under-deck spaces. The standard internal layout, in fact, is designed

with 3 cabins, each one with its own private bathroom, a saloon and a crew cabin with bathroom, characterized by precious materials and fabrics.

The G53' Pininfarina, sixteen metres long and about five metres large, represents a sea coupé which combines modernity and determination – typical characteristic of the whole Primatist line – with harmony and elegance of its clean lines, as well as the comfort of its interior design: a boat suitable to the family, but with a sporting soul that will know how to obtain the agreement of Primatist lovers.
